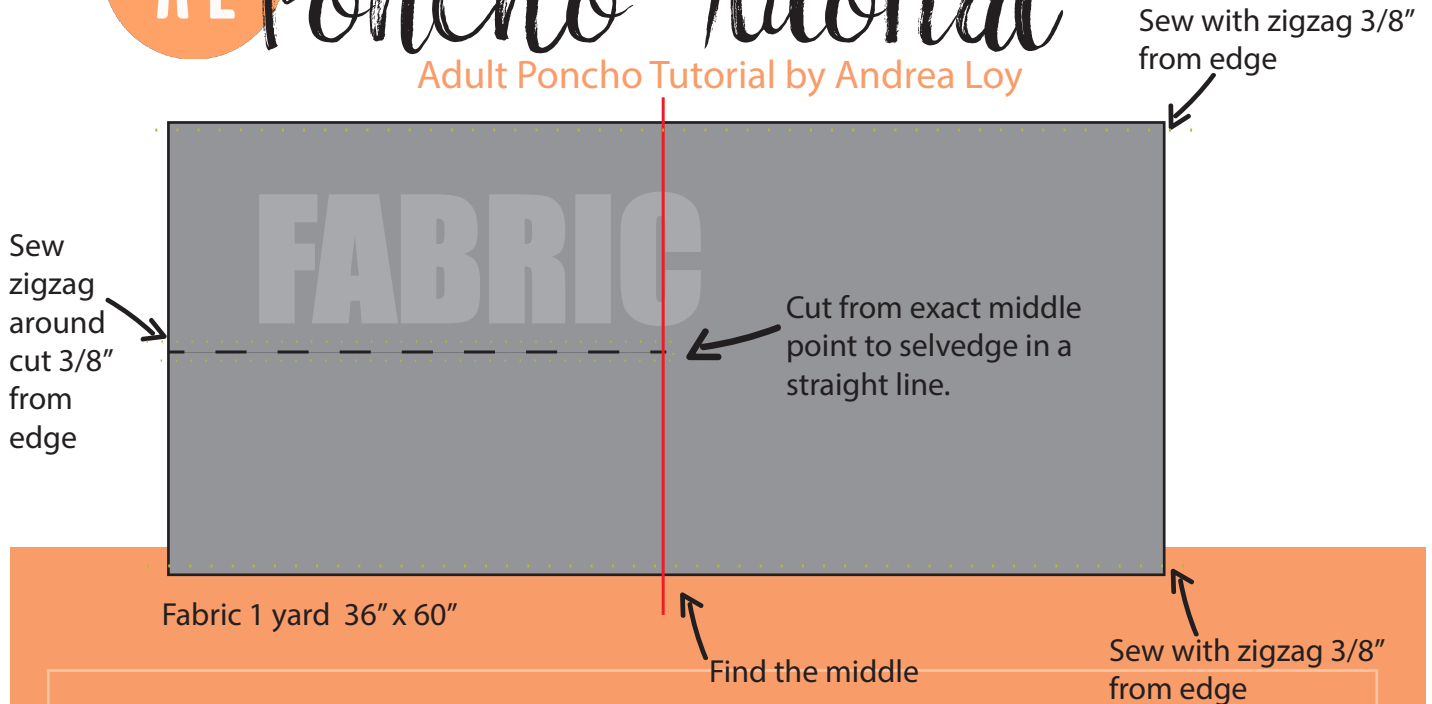


AL Poncho Tutorial

INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1. Start with 1 yard of 60" wide woven fabric. Total size should be 36" x 60".
- Step 2. Find the middle of your fabric piece. You can do this by laying it out and measuring or by folding it in half then half again. Cut from the very middle to the selvedge in a straight line.
- Step 3. Sew around the cut 3/8" away from edge with a zigzag or triple zigzag stitch from selvedge up to neck around and back down to selvedge to allow some fraying over time.
- Step 4. Sew the cut sides the same way 3/8" from edge with a zigzag.
- Step 5. Fold poncho, in half from the shoulder to the bottom....
- Step 6. Create an armhole so your poncho will lay properly. Pin the edge at the 10" mark and sew a 1/2" seam of zigzag stitching back and forth to secure the arm hole.

TO MAKE A CUSTOM SIZE: Measure with a tape from just below crotch up and over shoulder and down to just below rear.....This is your first measurement.

Next put arms up straight out and measure from bottom of one elbow straight across behind the neck to just below the other elbow. Second measurement. Your custome size is a rectangle of these two measurements. Perfect for kiddos! Estimate the arm tack spot to be approximately even across top of rib cage.



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Fold at middle (your shoulders)

Pin at 10" down from shoulder fold and sew a tack to create sleeve.
